**Readings Next Week (JUNE 11, 2023) THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST (A)**

***Deuteronomy 8:2-3,14b-16a***

Moses tells the people to remember how God delivered them from slavery in Egypt.

**Background on the Gospel Reading**

This Sunday we celebrate a second solemnity during this period of Ordinary Time in the liturgical calendar. Today is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. This day was once called *Corpus Christi*, which is Latin for "Body of Christ." In the revised Lectionary the name for this day is expanded to reflect more completely our Eucharistic theology.

John. The reading is part of a discourse between Jesus and a crowd of Jews. The discourse comes shortly after the miracle of Jesus' multiplication of the loaves and fishes. In John's Gospel, miracles such as this are identified as "signs" through which people come to believe that Jesus is the Son of God. These signs are followed by dialogue, or discourse that interprets and explains the miracle. In John's Gospel, Jesus' multiplication of the loaves is said to have occurred near Passover, thus linking it to the Exodus story and God's saving action toward the Israelites.

Having seen Jesus multiply the loaves and fishes, the crowd pursues him, perhaps seeking more food but also looking for another sign. Jesus tells the crowd that he is the bread of life. He explains that just as God gave the Israelites manna to sustain them in the desert, so now God has sent new manna that will give eternal life. It is in this context that Jesus repeats those words in today's Gospel and tells them again that he is the living bread that came down from heaven.

Jesus' words are not well understood by the crowd; they argue that Jesus is not from heaven but born of Mary and Joseph. The crowd also has trouble understanding how Jesus could give them his flesh to eat. Jesus tells them that when they eat his flesh and drink his blood, they will remain forever connected to him. These are difficult words, but they are important because they seek to show us our intimate connection with Jesus.

This is the mystery that is at the heart of our Eucharistic theology. In the elements of bread and wine, Jesus' Body and Blood are truly present. When we share in the Body and Blood of Christ, Jesus himself comes to dwell within us. This communion with the Lord makes us one body, brings us eternal life, and sends us forth to be Christ's Body in the world. (Loyola Press)

**What's that Word?"**

**TRINITY.....The Blessed Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith., the belief that the Father , the Son and the Holy Spirit, three distinct Persons, are one God and share a single divine nature. The Trinity is an eternal communion of love. The Father loves the Son and the Son loves the Father in return. The love between them is the very Person of the Holy Spirit. God invites each of us to share in this communion both in this life (especially through the sacraments) and in heaven. This is why he created us. The Christian family (a husband and wife together with their children) uniquely images the life-giving love of the Trinity.**

**Any Questions? .....Could you give a quick explanation of the Holy Trinity? "The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life." It is the mystery of God himself" (CCC 234) The Trinity could never have been known by human reason; it had to be revealed to us by God through the person of Jesus.**

**In the Old Testament, the Israelites understood God to be one: "Hear O Israel. The Lord our God is one Lord" (Deuteronomy 6:4) . When we say God is one, we are saying He is complete and unchangeable, one in his essence, being and substance. However, God is also a communion of Persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Although there are**

**three Persons, there is one common divine nature which each divine Person fully possesses. God invites each of us to share in the communion between the Father and the Son in their Spirit of love. That's why he created us.**

**Did you Know?.....According to tradition, St. Helena discovered the true Cross of Christ in the fourth century. Enshrined in the Church of the Holy Sepulcher in Jerusalem, it was recaptured by Muslim forces in the seventh century. However, fragments have been restored and Adoration of the Cross is observed each Good Friday in Jerusalem.**
