HOLIDAY: Fr. Vic will be on vacation leaving on Sept. 19 till Oct. 27 to visit his family in the Philippines. In his absence, Fr. Peter Wayow will take over.

CARPET CLEANED/DONATION: The three churches had their carpets/rugs cleaned/steamed professionally which incurred a total cost of \$3,124.16. The amount may be fairly high but it is a must that we do it this year since it has not been professionally cleaned in almost ten years. If you would consider making a donation to defray the cost kindly drop your cheques in the offertory basket. At the end of the year, you will receive from the church a receipt for your

personal charitable income tax deduction. Thank you so much for your generosity!

FOR THE INFORMATION OF EVERYONE...a levy is an assessment charged on the assessable receipts of a parish of the Roman Catholic Episcopal Corporation of the Diocese of Peterborough for the ongoing support of the diocesan programs, services and administration. Levy is assessed based on the following calculation method:

- A. DIOCESE—Category 1 is charged on all assessable offertory & donations as follows: 8% assessable income below \$50,000; 11.5% assessable income between \$50,001 and \$100,000; 15% assessable income between \$100,001 and \$200,000; 15.5% between \$200,001 and \$300,000.
- B. PRIEST BENEFIT FUND—Category 2, Levy rate is 5%
- C. Levy payments are due on the 1st day of each month and withdrawn directly from parish general bank accounts twelve(12) times per year. Each January the levy payment will change based on the Levy assessment for the two years previous Dec. 31st year-end, i.e. January 2020's levy will be calculated based on parishes' Dec. 31, 2018 financial statements.
- D. Collections and fundraising for ordinary repair and maintenance projects or work that is expected to occur in the normal life of a building are not exempt from levy. Examples of projects considered to be repair and maintenance projects are as follows: replacement of carpeting, minor repairs to equipment; landscaping and asphalt work; interior or exterior painting.
- E. Our current Diocesan levy is \$1,340.14 while the Priests Ben. Fund levy is \$419.45 all based on two year previous income.

Jesus teaches his disciples how to settle disputes in the Church.

Background on the Gospel Reading

Today's Gospel reading is taken from a chapter of Matthew's Gospel, which is sometimes called the "discourse on the Church" or the "church order" discourse. In this part of Matthew's Gospel, Jesus speaks more directly about matters of Church discipline and order. In today's reading we find one of only three instances in which Jesus uses the word *church* in Matthew's Gospel. In Matthew's record of Jesus' teaching, we can hear echoes of the kinds of issues faced by the early Christian community.

In the first part of the "discourse on the Church" (Matthew 18:1-14), Matthew addresses the Christian community's concerns about rank. Jesus responds to the disciples' question about who is greatest in the kingdom of heaven. Jesus indicates that those who wish to enter the kingdom of heaven must be like children, and he cautions those leaders who might lead these "little ones" astray. He also responds with the parable of the lost sheep, indicating how God will seek out and bring back those "little ones" who have strayed.

In today's Gospel reading, Matthew 18:15-20, Jesus addresses a common occurrence in the Christian community: a dispute between two members of the Church. Jesus outlines a procedure for settling such matters fairly. The victim should privately address the offender and attempt to resolve the dispute without outside involvement. If that fails, then the victim should bring two or three witnesses and confront the offender again. If the dispute is still unresolved, the matter should be brought to the attention of the entire community. If the offender refuses to adhere to the reparations prescribed by the community, then Jesus suggests that the offender may be expelled from the Church.

Jesus does not discourage disagreement within the community of the Church; he acknowledges the reality of conflict and error and offers his disciples a means for addressing such matters. It is in the conclusion to this teaching that the message of hope is found: Jesus is present with the community and will guide the community in its relations. If decisions are taken in prayer, then the community can be assured of God's assistance. (Loyola Press)


