**Readings Next Week (SEPT. 11, 2022) 24TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

*Exodus 32:7-11,13-14* (Moses stands up to God, recalling all of God's great promises.)

*1 Timothy 1:12-17* 9Paul proves it's never too late to repent and serve God.)

*Luke 15:1-32* (Jesus responds to those who criticize him for keeping company with the unworthy.)

**Background on the Gospel Reading**

In chapter 15 of Luke's Gospel, Jesus tells three parables about losing, finding, and rejoicing. The outcasts of society, the taxpayers, and the sinners approach Jesus eager to hear what he has to say. In Luke's Gospel, *hearing* is a sign of conversion. The Pharisees and scribes, still suspicious of Jesus, complain about him associating with sinners. So he tells them these three parables.

In the first story, the parable of The Lost Sheep, the shepherd leaves behind the 99 sheep to search for the 1 lost sheep. When he finds it, the shepherd rejoices not alone as in Matthew's version, but with friends and neighbors. In the same way, God rejoices more over 1 sinner who repents—like the outcasts who have come to hear Jesus—than over the 99 righteous like the Pharisees and scribes.

The second story, about a poor woman who will not stop searching until she finds her lost coin, makes the same point. Why are the Pharisees complaining? They should rejoice when the lost are found.

Finally we come to what is probably the most memorable parable in the Gospels, the story we know as The Prodigal Son. Just as in The Lost Sheep and The Lost Coin, this story (found only in Luke) is really about the seeker. The loving father is at the center of this parable. Even though his son runs off with his father's inheritance and squanders the money, the father waits for him, hoping for his return. Upon his son's return, the father, “full of compassion,” runs out to embrace and forgive him before the son can utter one word of repentance. At this point the rejoicing begins.

The parable does not end there. Rather, it makes one more point about the older son's reaction. This son who never left, just like the Pharisees and scribes who feel they are righteous, refuses to enter his father's house to join in the rejoicing. He has served his father. He has obeyed him. Perhaps it was not out of love. The father's response teaches us that God's care and compassion extend to the righteous and sinner alike. When we are lost, God doesn't wait for our return. He actively seeks us out. And when the lost are found, how could we not celebrate and rejoice (Loyola Press)

**REFLECTION: Sharing the Love of Christ “The Word Among Us**

**GIFTED BY THE SPIRIT.** God wants to give you an inner fire and a new boldness to evangelize. But it comes only from the joy of encountering him and knowing the magnifi-

cent love of his Spirit. As Pope Francis wrote, “Every Christian is a missionary to the extent that he or she has encountered the love of God in Christ Jesus.” (The Joy of the Gospel, 120) Or as the preparation document for the 2015 Synod of Bishops on the New Evangelization states, . The Gospel can only be transmitted on the basis of being with Jesus and living with Jesus...;and in a corresponding way, of feeling compelled to proclaim and share what is lived as a good and something positive and beautiful.”

Just as Jesus promised a new Pentecost to the Apostles, he promises you a new outpouring of his Holy Spirit, who is the source of zeal, compassion and all the gifts that you need to evangelize. Like the disciples and apostles in the early Church, God will grant you as many “Pentecosts,” or outpouring of the Spirit, as you need to share the good news about Jesus in your daily life.

The gift of zeal is just one of many different gifts and charisms that grow in you as you surrender more completely to the Holy Spirit and ask for the grace of missionary discipleship. Since the Holy Spirit is the principal agent of evangelization, your challenge is to receive him as a divine Person who loves you and who wants to be your teacher.

So ask the Spirit to fill you and to empower you for Christ's mission. Give him permission to endow you with all the spiritual gifts you need to reach out to people with the good news. Each of us must, as John Paul II urged, “allow ourselves to be filled with the ardor of the apostolic preaching which followed Pentecost. We must revive in ourselves the burning conviction of Paul, who cried out: “Woe to me if I do not preach the Gospel!” (to be continued).

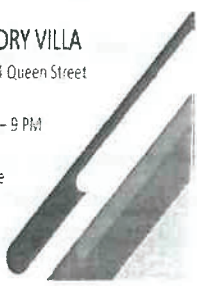
