**Background on the Gospel Reading**

Today we hear about how Jesus, continuing on his journey to Jerusalem, heals 10 lepers. This story is a lesson about faith and reminds us that faith is sometimes found in unlikely places. Ten people afflicted with leprosy cry out to Jesus. Struck with pity, Jesus heals all 10. However, only one is described as glorifying God and returning to thank Jesus. The one who returns is a Samaritan, a foreigner. In the Jewish circles in which Jesus lived, Samaritans were looked down upon because of the differences between the two communities in their observance of Judaism. It is significant, therefore, that Jesus commends the Samaritan for his faith, which has been his salvation. Throughout Luke's Gospel, faith is found in surprising places.

Another lesson for us in this Gospel has to do with salva-

**Funny Isn't It**

Funny how we need 2 or 3 weeks to fit a church event into our schedule, but can adjust it for a social event at the last minute.

Funny how people are so consumed with what others think about them rather than what God thinks about them.

**REFLECTION: "Do Whatever He Tells You"**  
*The Word Among Us*

The most important key to being an instrument of the Lord is given by the person who knew him best, his mother. When she saw that the wine was running out, she told the servants, "Do whatever he tells you" (John 2:5). Seeing six huge stone jars standing nearby, Jesus then told the servants to fill the jars with water. We have to realize that from a human point of view, this instruction made no sense. The problem was not a lack of water, but a lack of wine. The servants could easily have grumbled or outright refused: "What a ridiculous command!" It was no easy job to fill these jars, each holding twenty to thirty gallons. Yet these servants, on the strength of Mary's word, obeyed Jesus and filled the jars to the brim. Their response is a model of prompt and enthusiastic obedience. And it made way for the Lord to work his first miracle.

How often the Holy Spirit gives us impressions or promptings that we resist because they do not seem to make sense or are not according to our plan! To see the Lord's healing power requires listening to him, choosing to be obedient, taking risks, and trusting that he will lead us. And most of the Holy Spirit's promptings are very simple: Go talk to that person. Call that person, Tell that man the Lord loves him and understand the pain he is going through Ask the lady sitting over there if she would like prayer for anything.

Jesus wants to use us - you and me - as his instruments to share the good news and bring his healing power to the world. He is calling us to draw near to him, to ask him for what we need, and to obey him in all things. That's how we cooperate with his grace and power. That's how we become the missionary disciples he has called us to be.

**St. Francis of Assisi**  
(circa 1181-1226)

Known as a saint who most closely modeled Jesus through the manner in which he lived his life, Francis chose poverty, preached boldly and cared for animals and creation. But he was not always so close to Jesus. Born into a wealthy family, Francis lived a free-spirited life as a young man and especially enjoyed wearing fine clothes and spending money freely. However, in his mid-twenties, a severe illness prompted spiritual reflection, causing him to abandon his selfish ways and embrace poverty. Soon after, he had a vision of Jesus. Jesus asked him to "build up my house," which Francis eventually came to discern meant the Church. Francis gained followers, who were attracted by his example, and eventually founded the Franciscan Orders. For the last two years of his life, Francis suffered with the visible wounds of Christ, the stigmata.

His feast day (October 4) is usually recognized in faith communities by hosting a "blessing of the animals."

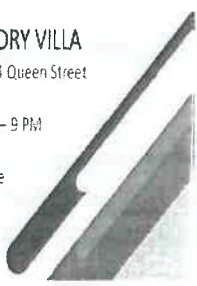
